

POLELED FLAG LIGHTING GUIDE

U.S. flags and all other country flags must be illuminated when flown at night. Visibility is dependent on the relative position of the luminair, flag and viewer, as well as the position on the flag pole. These rules of thump should result in a satisfactory installation, regardless of the many variables involved.

- 1. With the PoleLed luminair you ensure that the flag is adequately illuminated, regardless of wind direction. You only need one luminair.
- 2. In order to get a result at your satisfaction we advice you to mount the iluminair on the proper height as shown in the drawing
